# GARY ROBSON TO RELEASE 30TH BOOK

Montana children's author makes his first foray into fantasy genre

**Red Lodge, MT, 27 February 2026:** Montana author Gary D. Robson, best known for his award-winning children's series, *Who Pooped in the Park*, is releasing his first fantasy novel on April 7. The book, titled *The Bounds of Magic*, is the first in a planned series called the Tryllevær Saga.

"The seeds of this story have been germinating in my head for years," Robson said. "Finally, I sat down to write it over two years ago. After so many years of writing nonfiction and children's books, it's been an incredible experience to see my characters and their world take shape."

*Sko has tolerated a lot of abuse from his father, but he went too far when he hit Sko's best friend, Dacey. Sko strikes back and has to flee town with Dacey without knowing if his father is dead or alive. On the road, their friendship blossoms into much more. Sko also finds that his self-taught magic is unique and extremely powerful. This draws the unwanted attention of a powerful necromancer and Sko finds that—like it or not—his fate and Dacey's are tied to his magic. Is his newfound magic worth it or should he go back to his childhood dream of being a storyteller? Does he even have a choice anymore?*
